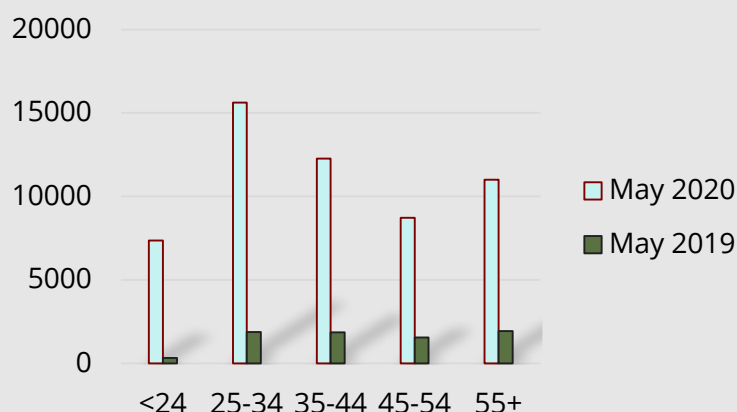

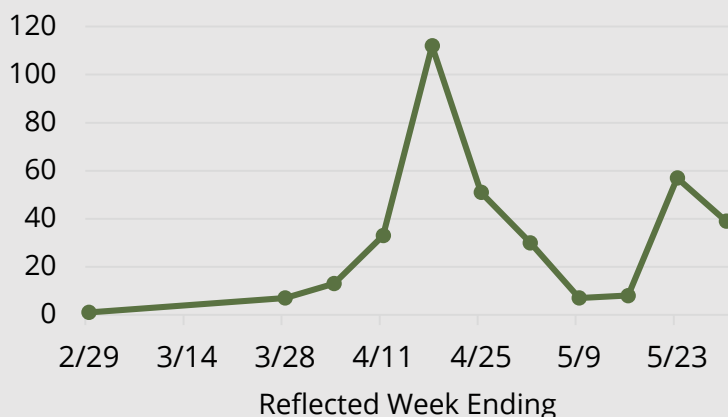

When Aleutians East claimants received their first payment



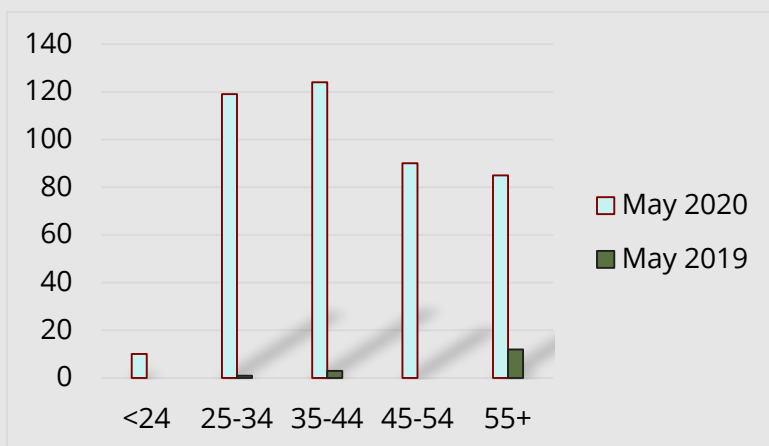

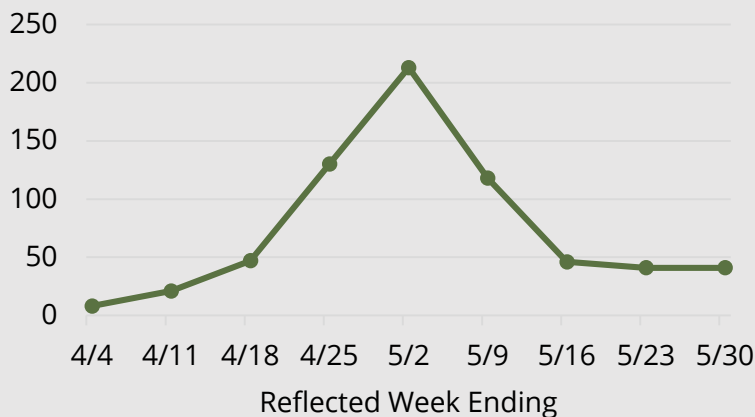

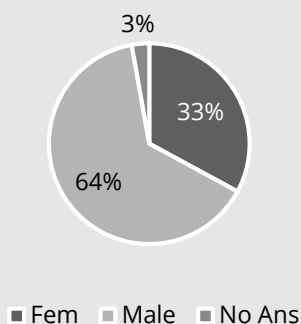

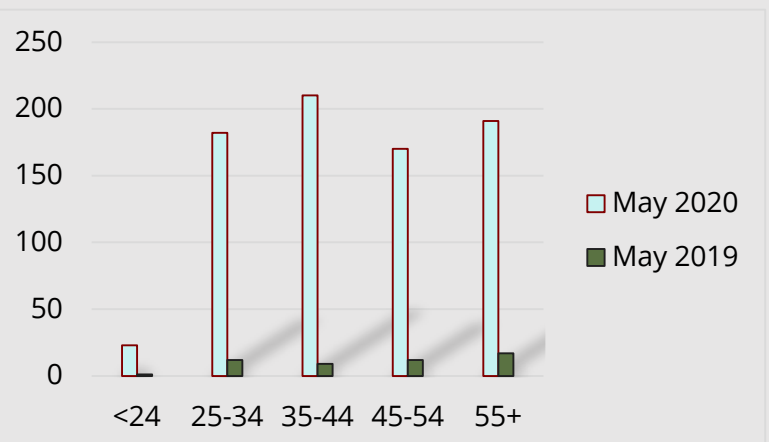

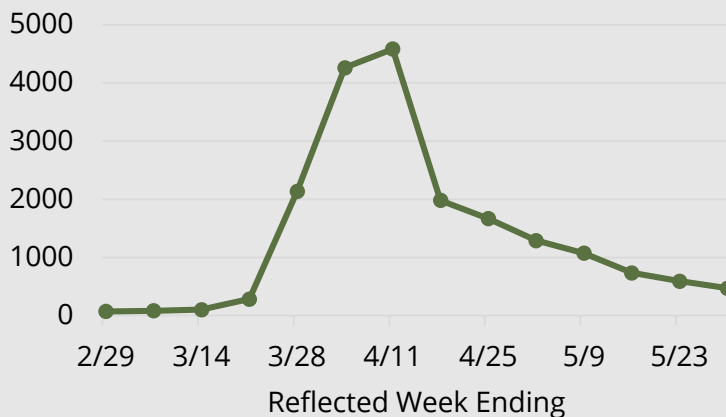

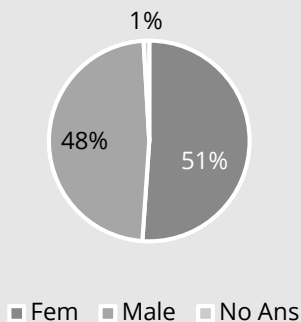

When Anchorage claimants received their first payment



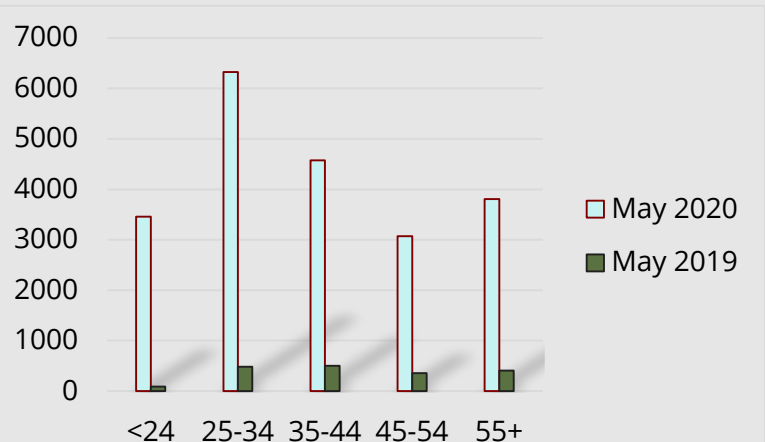

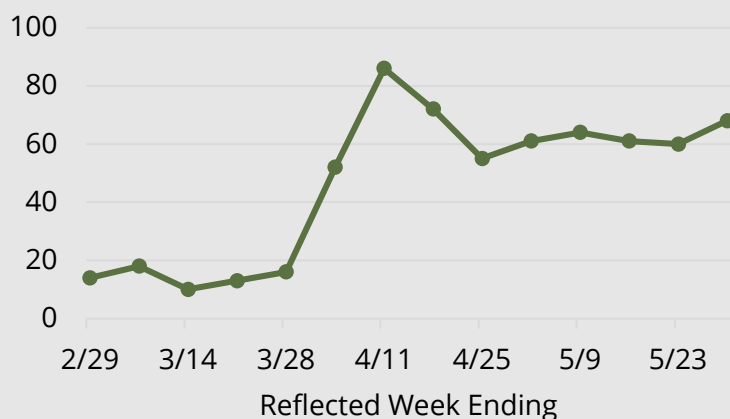

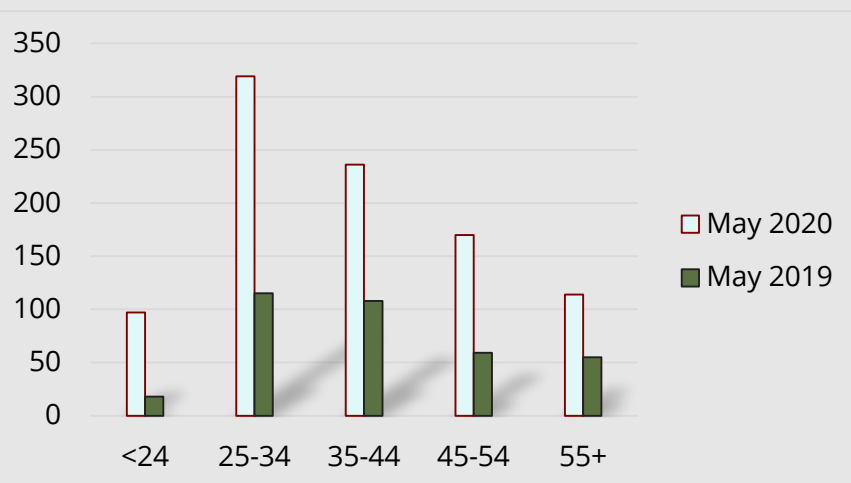

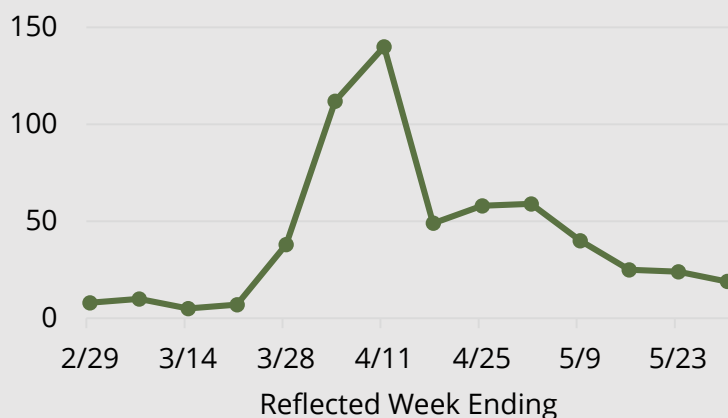

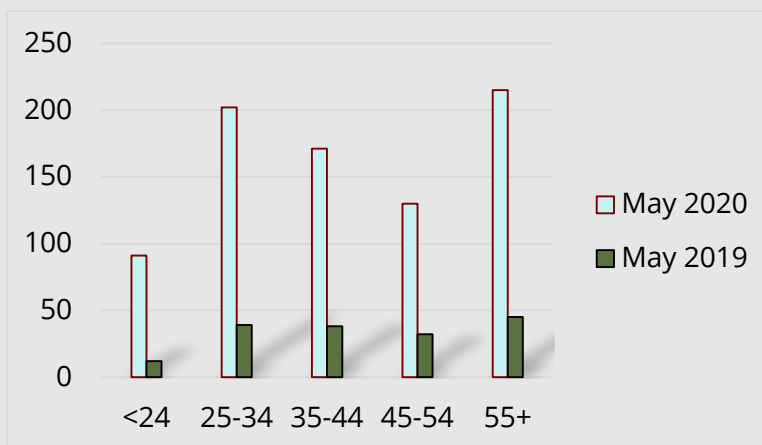

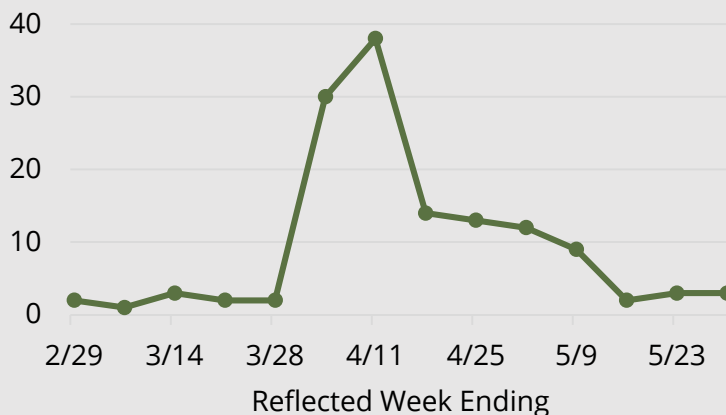

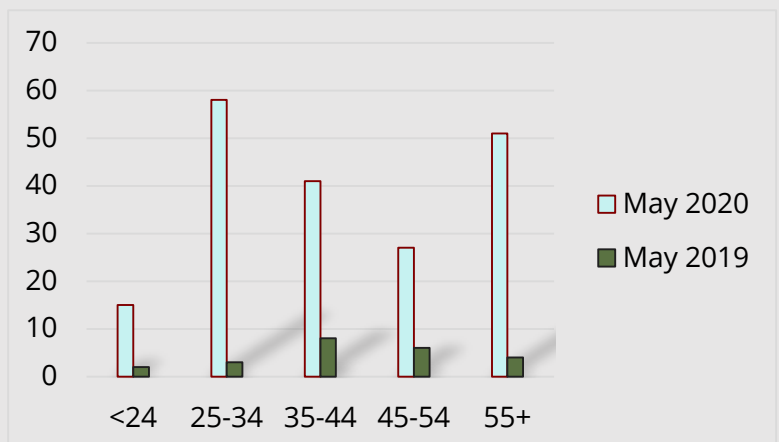

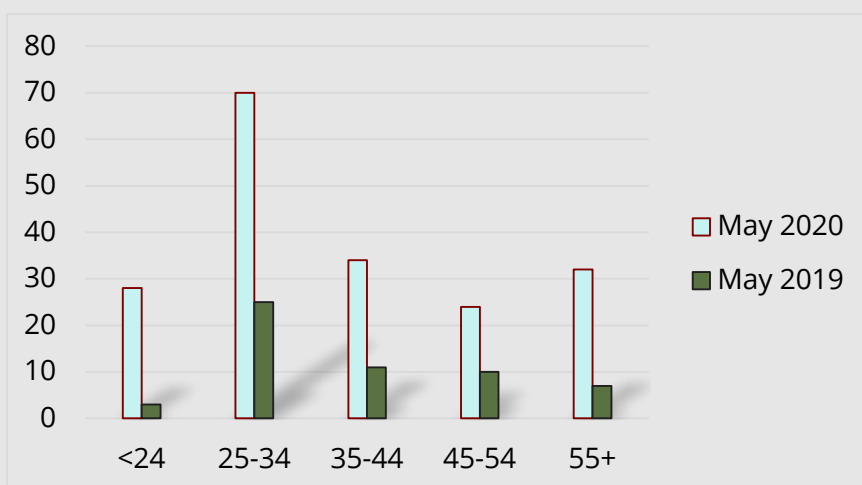

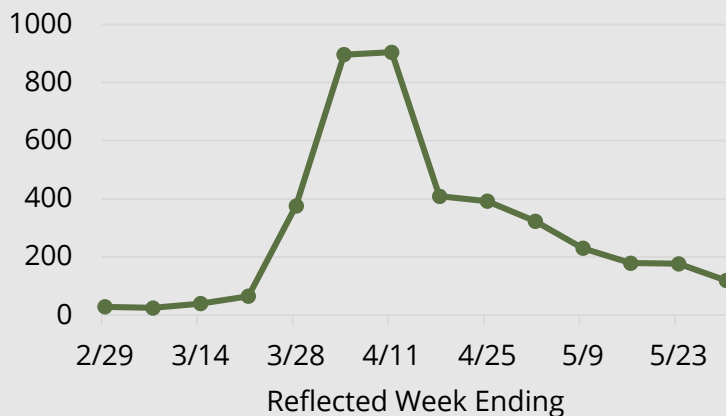

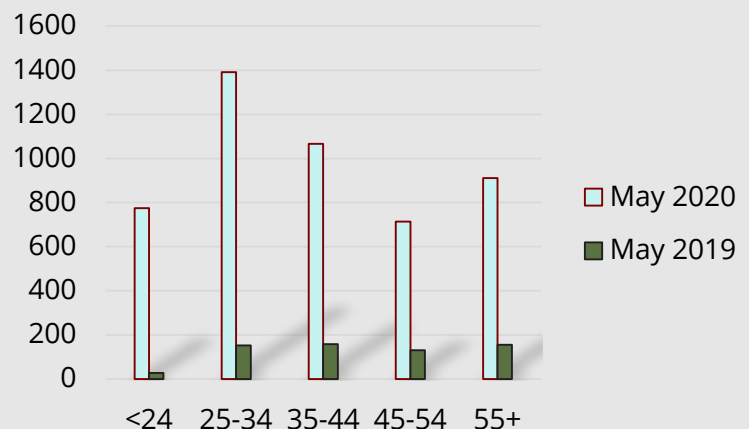

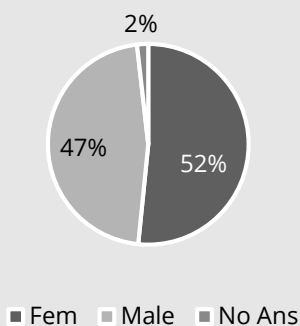

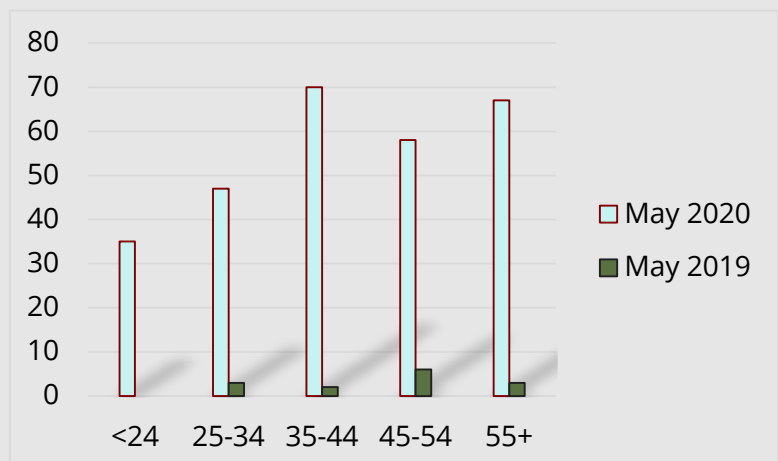

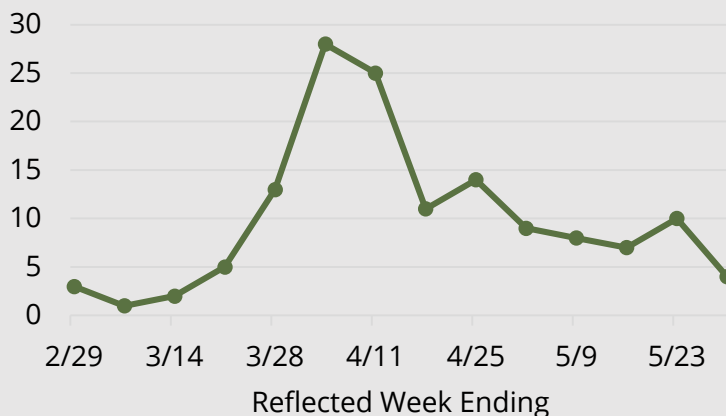

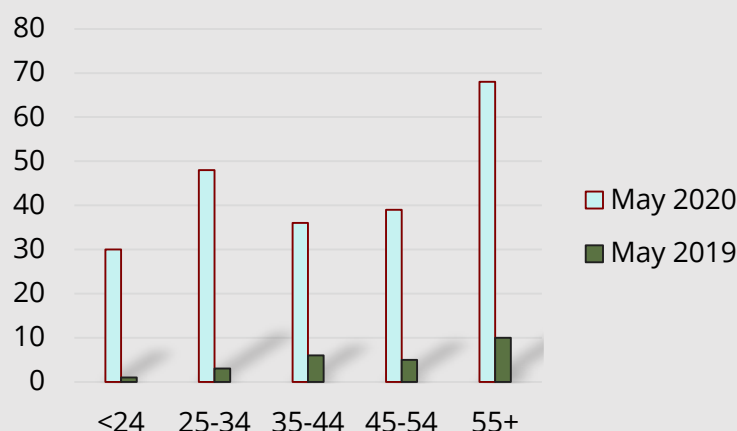

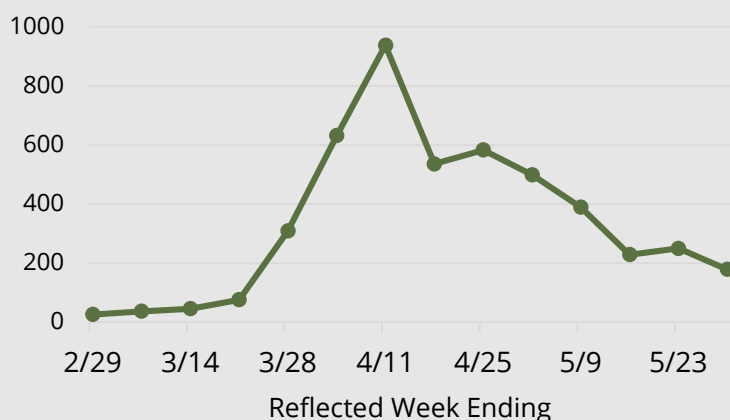

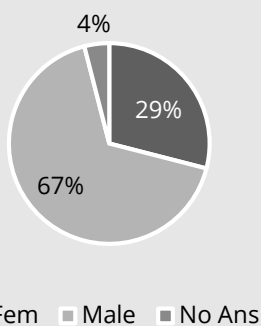

When Interstate claimants received their first payment



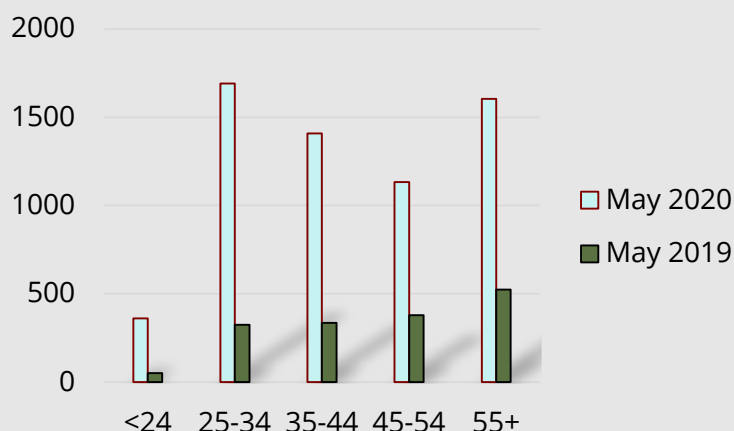

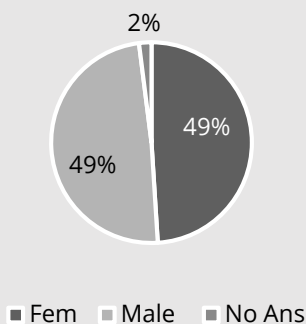

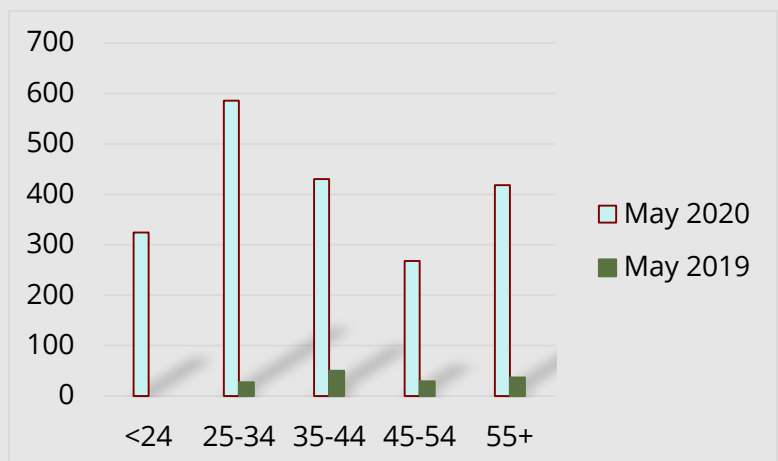

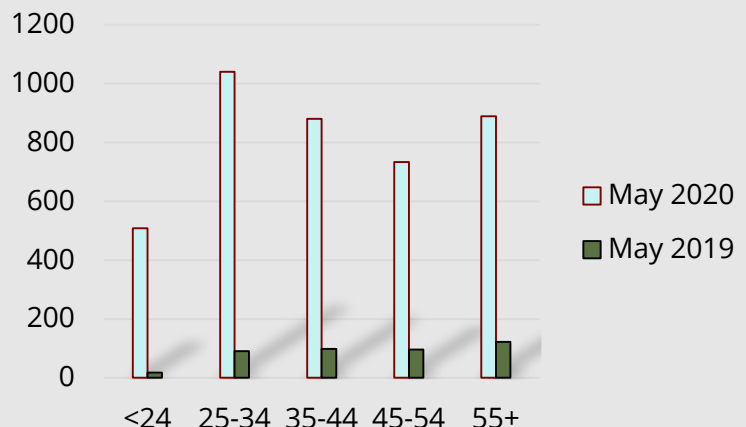

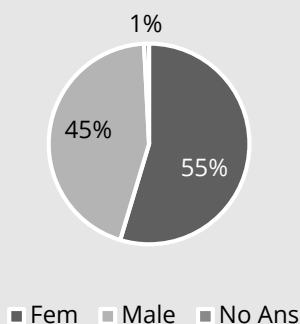

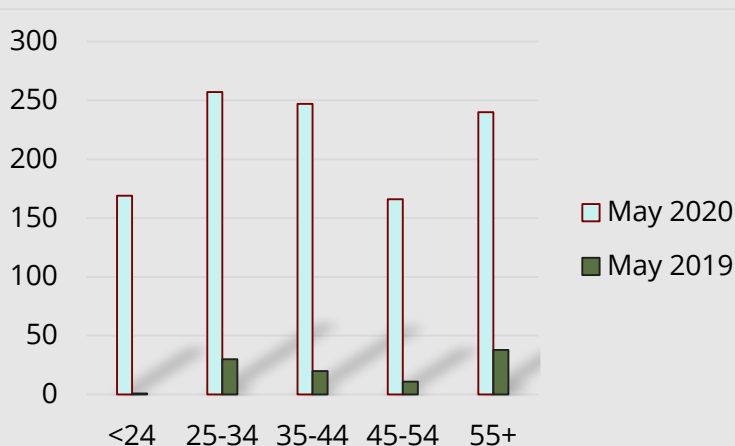

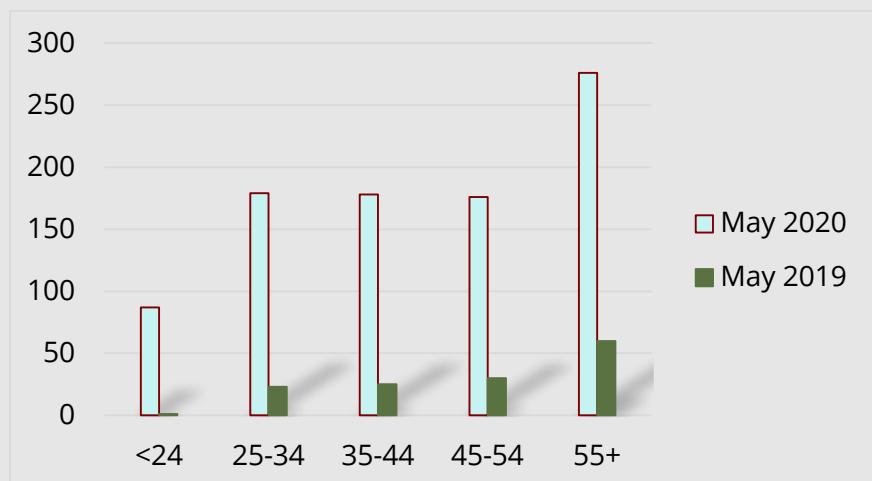

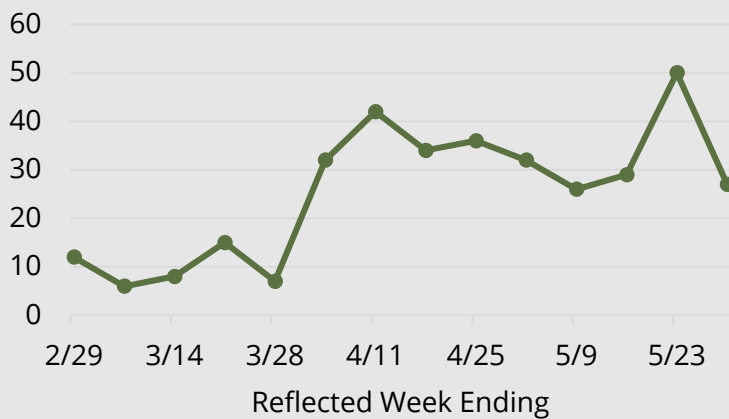

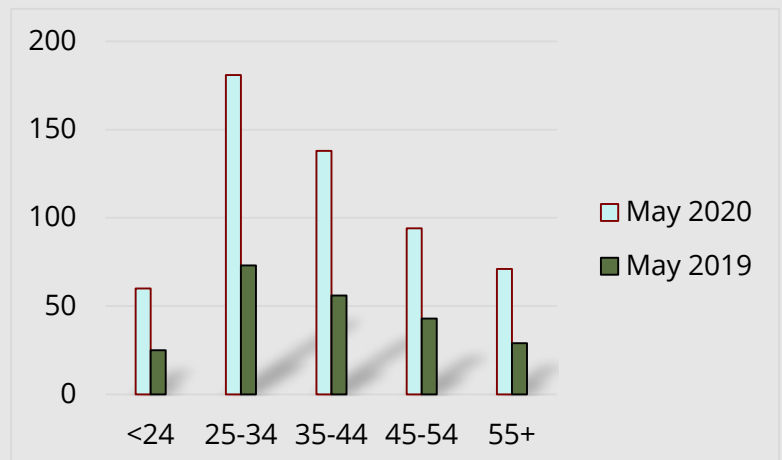

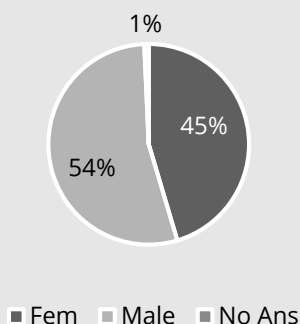

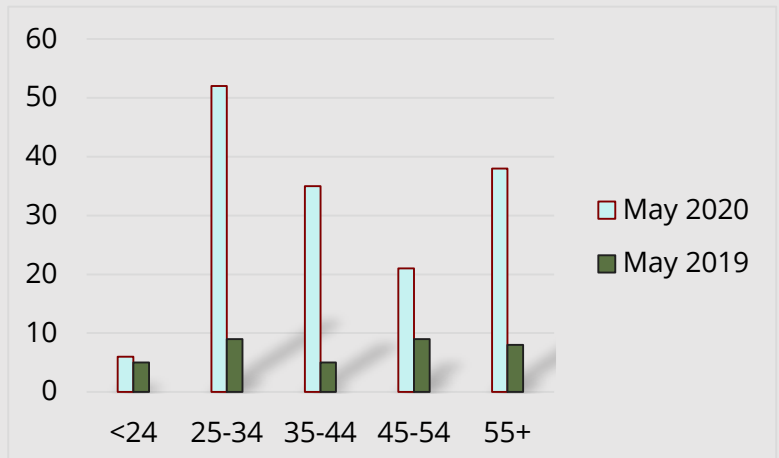

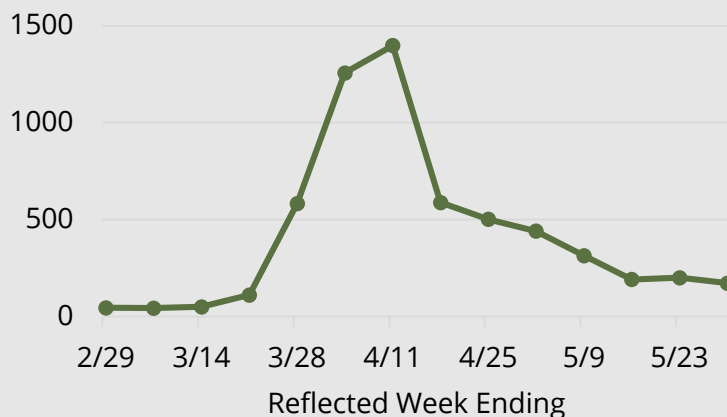

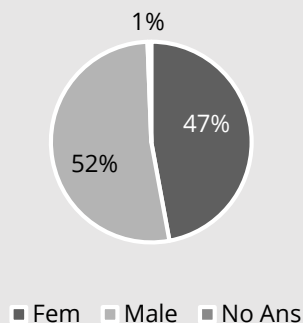

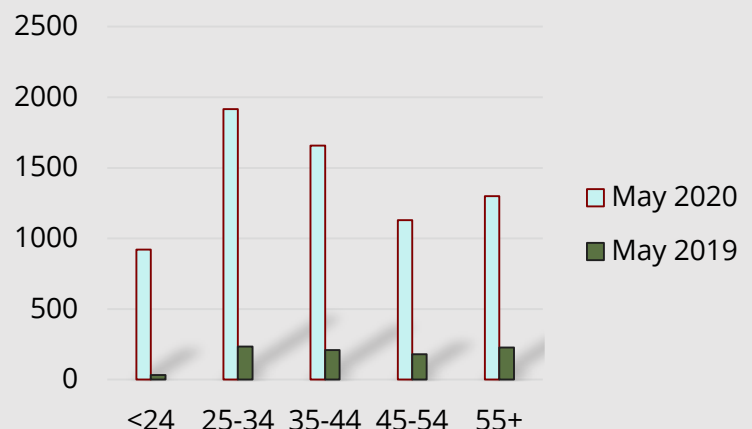

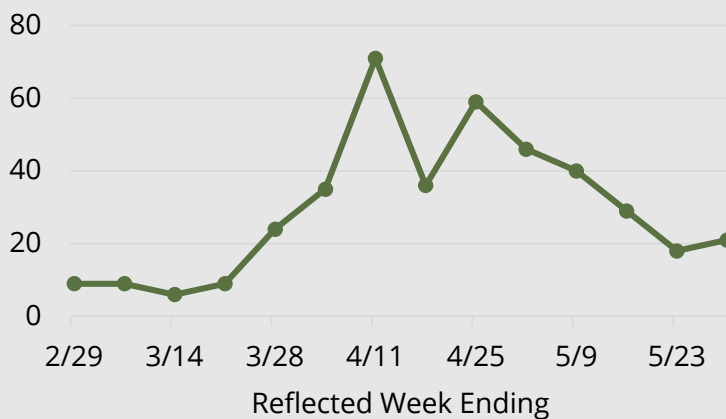

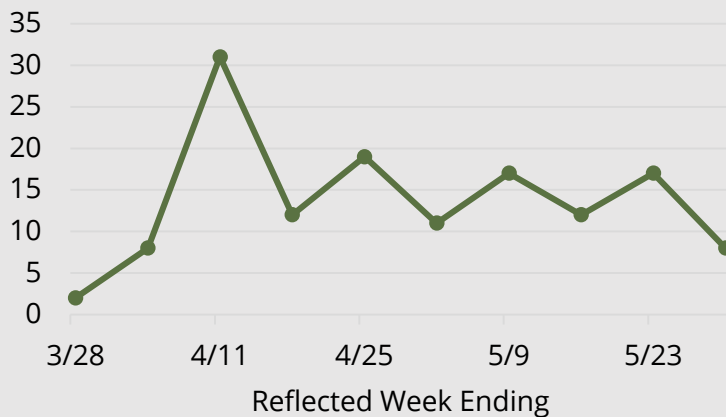

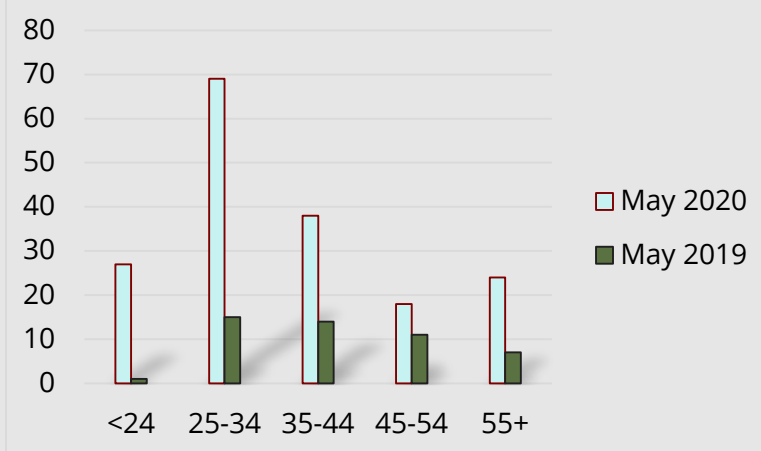

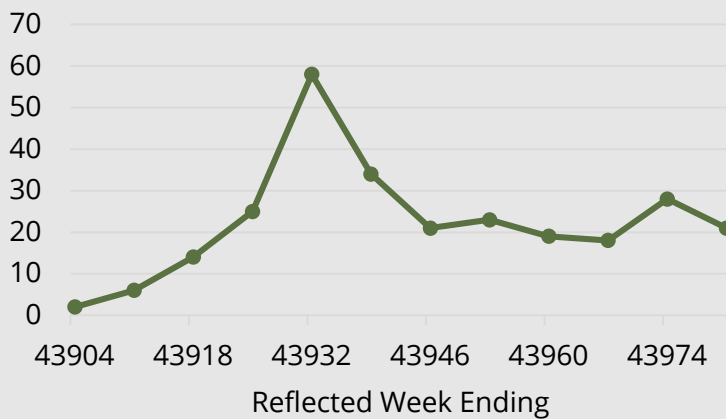

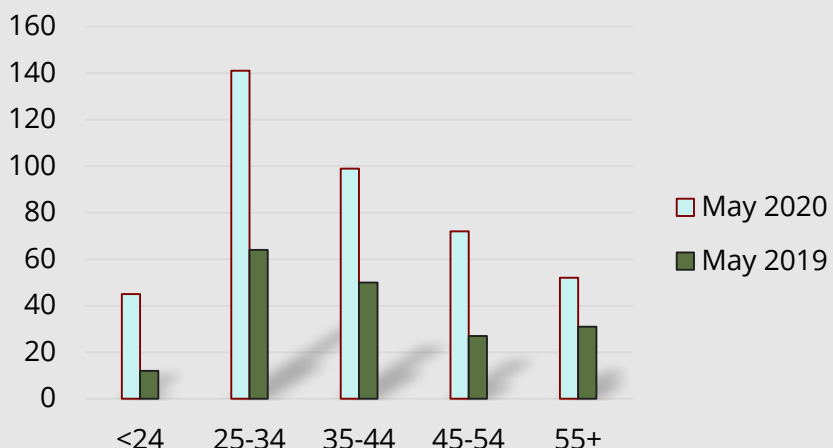

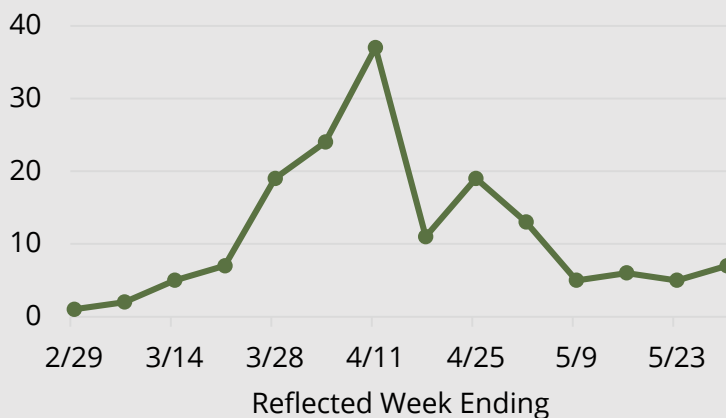

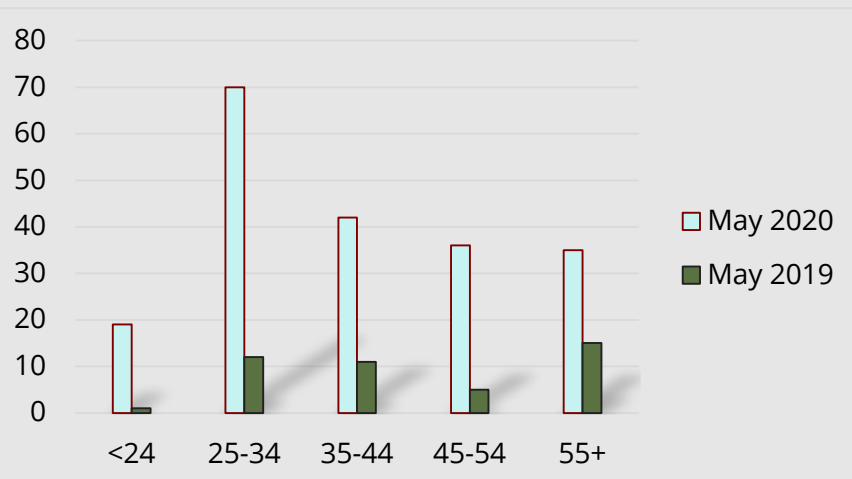

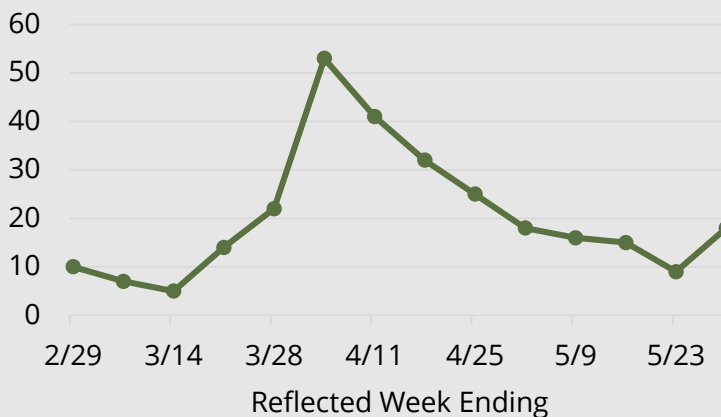

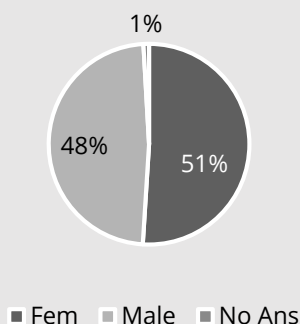

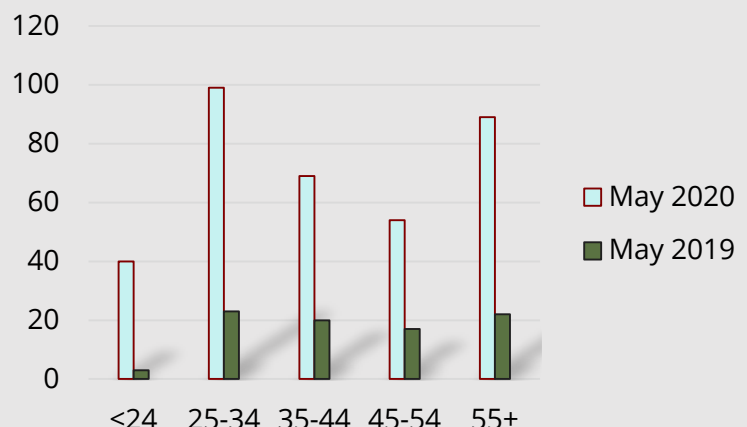

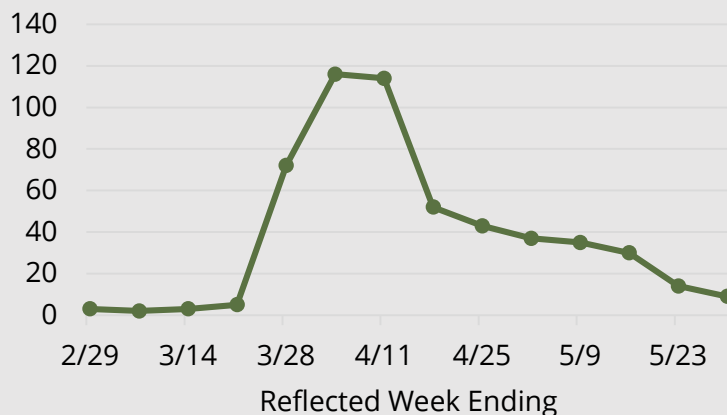

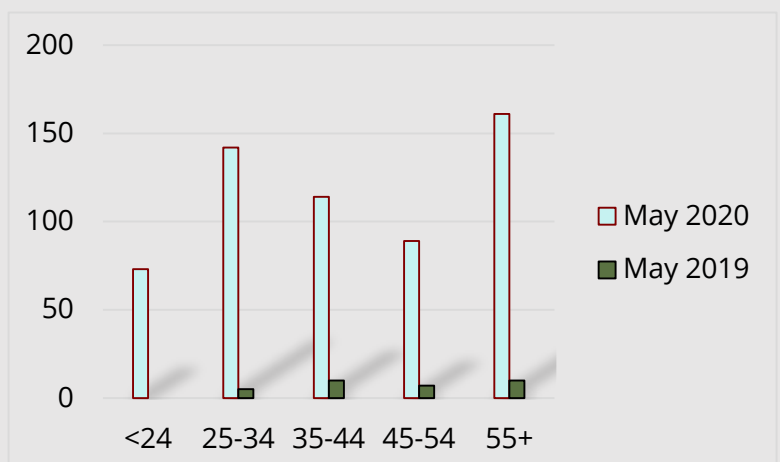

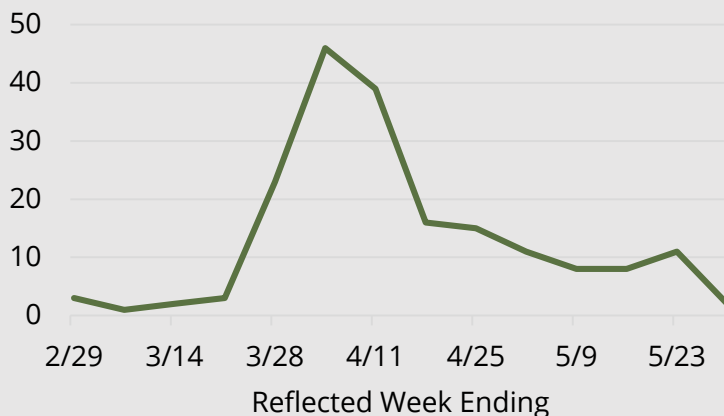

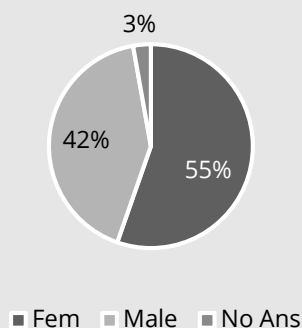

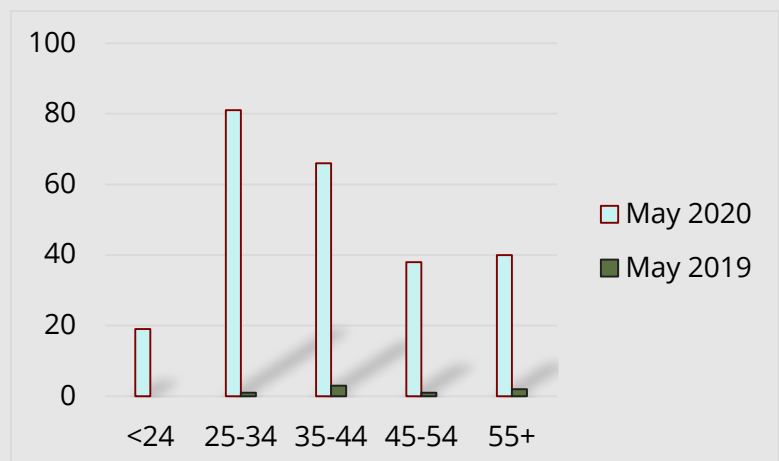

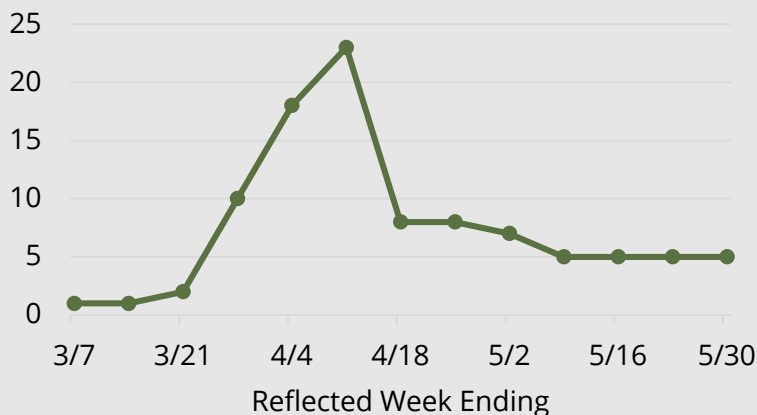

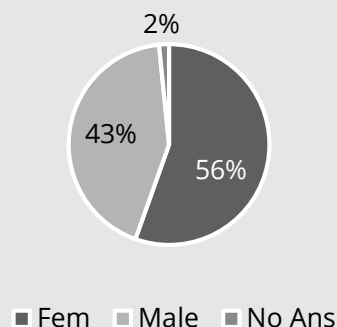

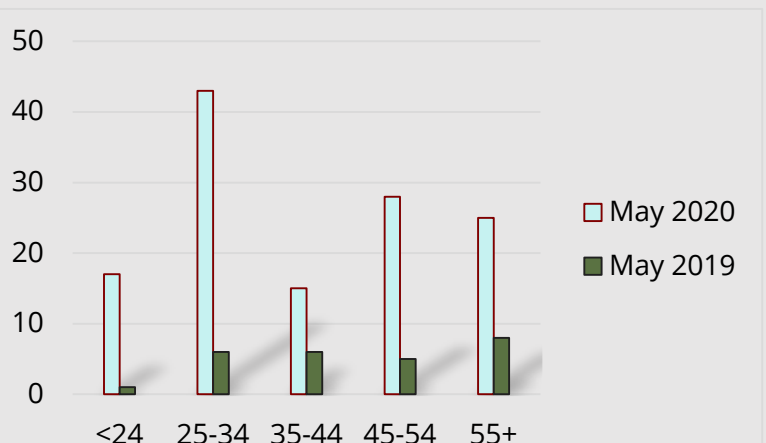

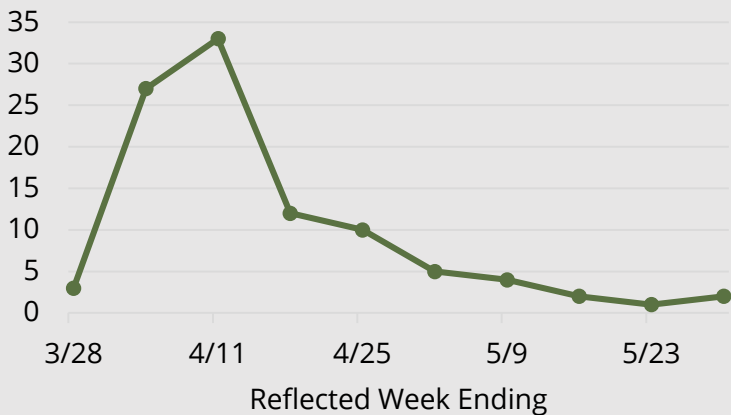

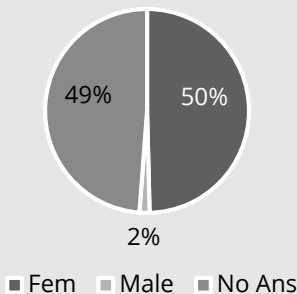

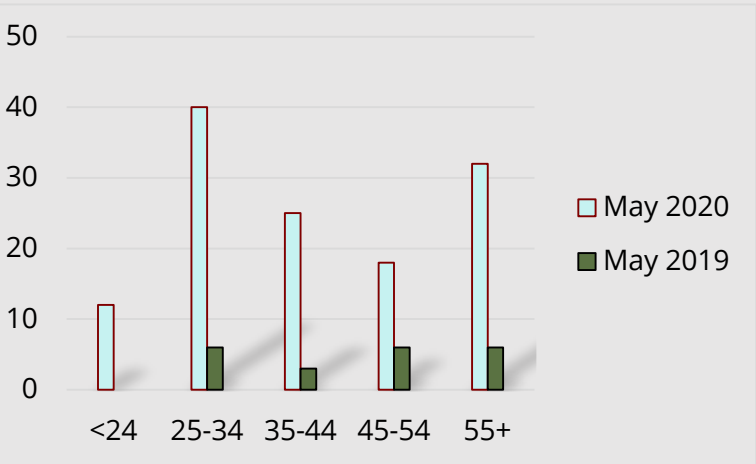

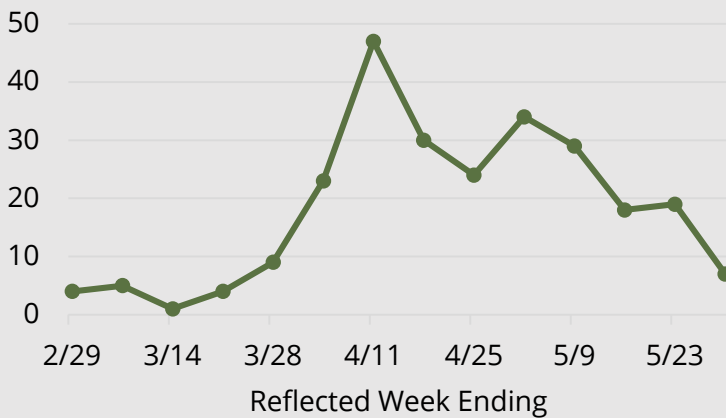

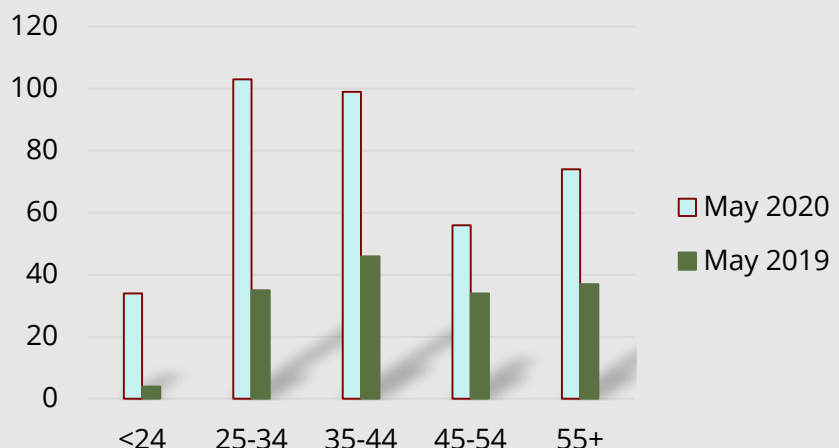
